

# Directions to Urasoe City Museum

To get to the museum from Kadena, one can either take the Okinawa Highway or follow National Route 58 down the coast. I'll explain both routes:

From the Okinawa Highway, take the Nishihara IC exit and follow the signs to get onto the 330 (Bypass) going south toward Naha. Get off the 330 at the Ohira IC exit and turn left onto Prefectural Route 38. You will be going up a hill. Within a few hundred feet, you should start seeing signs directing you to the art museum. You will see a gas station on your left. Turn left at the next light and go past the Urasoe City Library (the library will be on your right). You will see Tedako Hall in front of you, slightly to the left. It is possible to park in the Tedako Hall parking lot or follow the signs to parking for the Urasoe Art Museum, which is just a short walk from Tedako Hall (follow the signs and or use the attached map!)

From National Route 58, go south from Kadena until you reach Urasoe. At the Camp Kinser Gusukuma Gate Intersection, take a left. At this point you will start heading east across the island. You will follow this road past a large shopping center and start going uphill. After about a mile, you will connect with a large intersection that will put you on Prefectural Route 38. Go straight through the intersection (there will be a McDonald's on your left). Follow Route 38 up the hill and over the Bypass (330). Within a few hundred feet, you should start seeing signs directing you to the art museum. You will see a gas station on your left. Turn left at the next light and go past the Urasoe City Library (the library will be on your right). You will see Tedako Hall in front of you, slightly to the left. It is possible to park in the Tedako Hall parking lot or follow the signs to parking for the Urasoe Art Museum, which is just a short walk from Tedako Hall (follow the signs and or use the attached map!)
